

Dear General Members,

Please find attached the assignments for 2018 Spring Night Watch duty.

### **Listed below are your responsibilities of Night Watch:**

1. Watch hours are from 11:30p.m. - 4:00a.m.
2. Members are expected to stand their watch on their assigned date. If you cannot stand your watch on the assigned date, then it is your responsibility to exchange a date with another member. Please notify the Commodore of any changes in the schedule so records can be updated.
3. Members should sign in on the night watch schedule posted in the clubhouse.
4. Members who miss their assigned date, or fail to reschedule a missed date will be assessed a \$100.00 fine.
5. If your watch mate does not shown up for his/her watch, please call your watch mate utilizing the phone number listed on the night watch schedule.

### **Summary of Duties While on Night Watch**

1. Scan parking lot every half hour utilizing the searchlight located in the clubhouse galley.
2. Patrol the mooring field throughout the night utilizing the club tender (weather permitting and only if watch mate is present for duty).
3. Report any suspicious activities to proper authorities (ie: Weymouth or Hingham Police).  
**Do not take any action that could endanger yourself or others.**
4. Police the clubhouse. Empty garbage containers, sweep and mop the floor, wipe the countertops, dispose of spoiled food in refrigerator.
5. Each night there may be an assigned task. Please make sure task is performed.
6. Secure the clubhouse and leave the hallway lights on upon conclusion of your duty.

Night watch is an important duty, one that we all must take seriously. Not only does it provide security for our club, but it is also a means protecting our boats from ill intent. If you feel uncomfortable, or you feel you cannot perform the duties of night watch, please contact the Commodore or any Flag Officer for assistance.
